

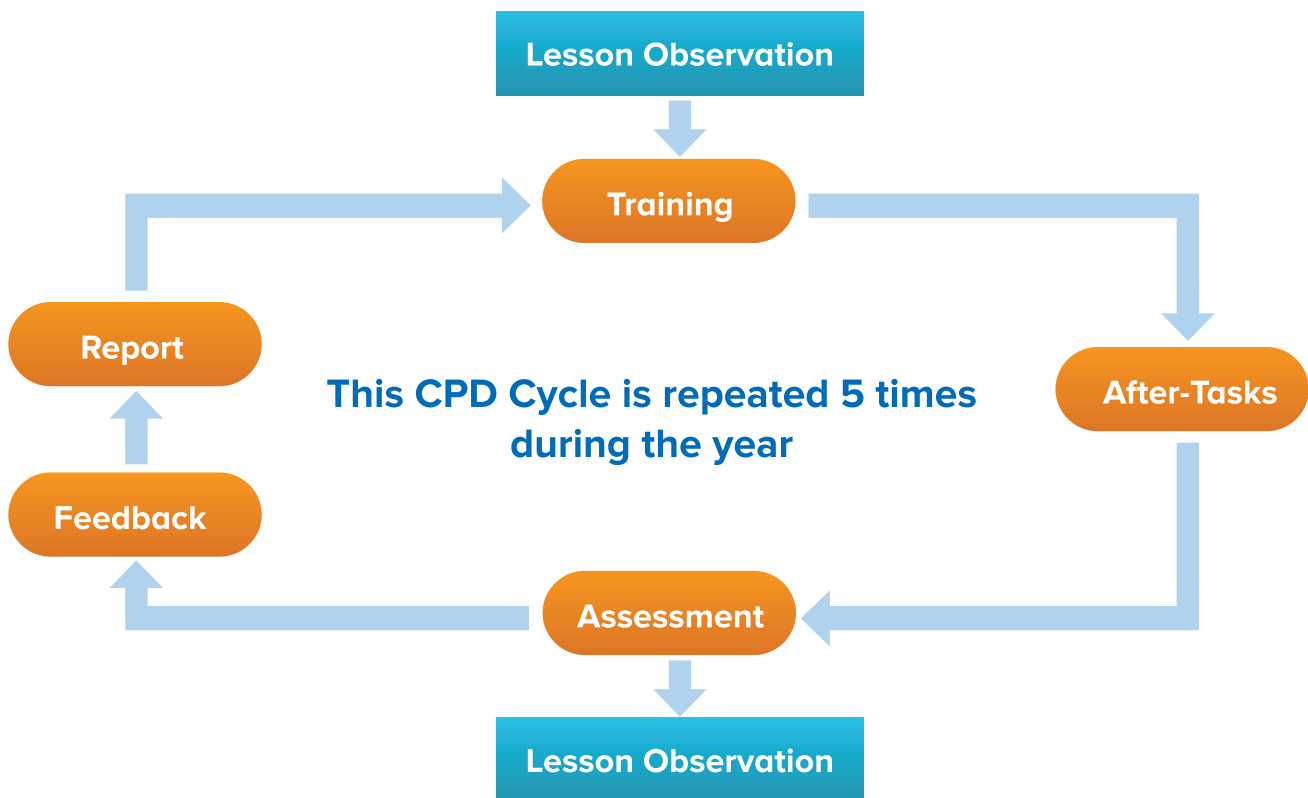
Objectives of CPD

Continuous Professional Development is a programme designed to improve the quality of teaching and learning within the school.
